Dear Prof Abbas,

Referring to your e-mail letters concerning meeting to consider measures to protect IRAQI Academics

I have put on different occasions some ideas and thoughts how to deal with the matter; I will mention some of them which might assist your meeting dialogue.

Most of the crimes take place during the business hours and mainly on the way from home to office or vice versa.

For this reason we purpose to build a residential complex near the university or inside its campus. The complex can be easily protected by university guards or police in addition to it's nearness to the job places so that there is no manoeuvre for the insurgents to carry out their criminal acts.

Secondly for those Doctors who like to practice medicine outside the college, the University can rent one or more building which is also guarded.

Thirdly, there are many cases where the assassination or the Kidnapping came after a letter of threat was issued. We propose to ask the professor to leave the country for awhile (say one month).

The above suggestions or proposals together with other's (not mentioned) might greatly reduce the threat. However it requires your support and if you feel satisfied then you can discuss it during the meeting.
